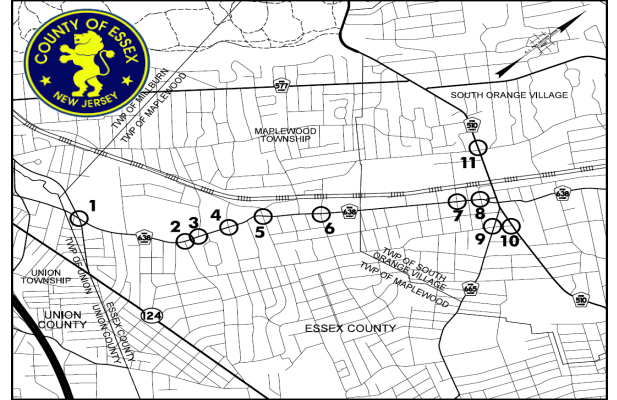

SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO ELEVEN INTERSECTIONS

Maplewood Township & South Orange Village, Essex County, New Jersey

Essex County will be presenting plans for improvements to eleven intersections in Maplewood Township and South Orange Village at the Maplewood Town Council Meeting to be held on Tuesday, July 19th at 7:30 PM via Zoom. The intersections to be improved are:

1. Valley Street (CR 638) & Milburn Avenue (CR 630)
2. Valley Street (CR 638) & Tuscan Road
3. Valley Street (CR 638) & Baker Street
4. Valley Street (CR 638) & Oakview Avenue
5. Valley Street (CR 638) & Oakland Road
6. Valley Street (CR 638) & Parker Avenue
7. Valley Street (CR 638) & Third Street
8. Valley Street (CR 638) & First Street
9. Irvington Avenue (CR 665) & Prospect Street
10. South Orange Avenue (CR 510) & Prospect Street
11. South Orange Avenue & Ridgewood Road



The planned improvements include replacement / addition of traffic signal equipment, as well as related sidewalk, ADA ramp, and drainage upgrades. The public can join the meeting to obtain additional information and ask questions using the following online link:
